Esophageal Disorders

- Functional chest pain
- Functional heartburn
- Reflux hypersensitivity
- Globus
- Functional dysphagia

Gastroduodenal Disorders

- Functional dyspepsia
 - Postprandial distress syndrome (PDS)
 - Epigastric pain syndrome (EPS)
- Belching disorders
 - o Excessive supragastric belching
 - o Excessive gastric belching
- Nausea and vomiting disorders
 - Chronic nausea vomiting syndrome (CNVS)
 - Cyclic vomiting syndrome (CVS)
 - Cannabinoid hyperemesis syndrome (CHS)
- Rumination syndrome

Bowel Disorders

- Irritable bowel syndrome (IBS)*
 - IBS with predominant constipation (IBS-C)
 - o IBS with predominant diarrhea (IBS-D)
 - IBS with mixed bowel habits (IBS-M)
 - o IBS unclassified (IBS-U)
- Functional constipation
- Functional diarrhea
- Functional abdominal bloating/distension
- Unspecified functional bowel disorder
- Opioid-induced constipation

Centrally Mediated Disorders of Gastrointestinal Pain **

- Centrally mediated abdominal pain syndrome (CAPS)
- Narcotic bowel syndrome (NBS) / Opioid-induced GI hyperalgesia

Gallbladder and Sphincter of Oddi (SO) Disorders

- Biliary pain
 - o Functional gallbladder disorder
 - o Functional biliary SO disorder
- Functional pancreatic SO disorder

Anorectal Disorders

- Fecal incontinence
- Functional anorectal pain
 - Levator ani syndrome
 - o Unspecified functional anorectal pain
 - Proctalgia fugax
- Functional defecation disorders
 - Inadequate defecatory propulsion
 - Dyssynergic defecation
